1. Call to Order: Chairman Richard Handfield called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

- 2. Business:
 - a. Discuss and act on FY 2017-18 Budget Proposal:
 - Discuss and act on requesting the Board of Selectmen to bring to a Special Town Meeting a proposed 2017-2018 budget.

First Selectman, Rich Matters, noted he has received State of Connecticut Revenue numbers and has worked these numbers into the Town of Franklin Municipal Budget. As a result, he provided the Board of Finance with a Proposed Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Municipal Budget with an estimated shortfall of \$263,134. In response BOF reviewed financial scenarios that could be used in finalizing the 2017-2018 Board of Selectmen and Board of Education Budgets.

Decrease the Board of Selectmen Proposed Budget: \$225,000
Decrease the Board of Education Proposed Budget: \$46,164

Utilize General Fund: \$102,400 (approximate)

Increase Mil Rate: .5

TOTAL Proposed Municipal Budget: \$6,573,459 (represents a 2.1% increase)

BOS Budget \$2,572,733
BOE Budget \$4,000,726

Total Expenditures: \$6,573,459

Total Revenue: \$1,358,597 Revenue to be Raised by Taxes: \$5,214,862
