Subject:	Erosion Control Measures on Rt. 32

On July 7, 2020, Mr. Charles Grant notified me that the silt fences acting as Erosion and Sediment (E&S) Controls along the construction site of the utilities expansion along Route 32 in Franklin were failing. E&S controls are crucial to keeping disturbed soil on the construction site and preventing runoff onto neighboring property or into waterways during storms.

I drove north and south on Route 32 through the construction area around 11 AM, and the silt fences were down in numerous locations. E&S controls along the construction site need to be repaired and maintained immediately to protect neighboring properties ahead of storms with possible rainfall over half an inch this weekend.
